



### CPC 2021: A Year Of Radical Devotion

*For the Scripture says, "WHOEVER BELIEVES IN HIM [whoever adheres to, trusts in, and relies on Him, Jesus] WILL NOT BE DISAPPOINTED."*  
**Romans 10:11 (AMP)**

*"...blessed are those who trust in the LORD and have made the LORD their hope and confidence. They are like trees planted along a riverbank, with roots that reach deep into the water. Such trees are not bothered by the heat or worried by long months of drought. Their leaves stay green, and they never stop producing fruit." Jeremiah 17:7-8 (NLT)*

Radical comes from the Latin word *Radicalis* = **ROOTED**

How does one become deeply rooted? It requires **DEVOTION**.

Case study of the Radically Devoted: Acts 2:42-47

*All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, and to fellowship and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer. A deep sense of awe came over them all, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders. And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. They sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need. They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved. Acts 2:42-47 (NLT)*

## **2021: The year of becoming Radically Devoted- How?**

1. By growing my **worship** of the one true Savior and Lord **Jesus Christ** above anything and anyone. (Acts 2:46-47a)
2. By **growing deeper** in His truth and **living** my life by that truth. (Acts 2:42)
3. By **committing** myself to a deeper relationship to that which He loves, **His family** (one another). (Acts 2:42b-43)
4. By intentionally and generously **using** what He has given **me** to take care of His family and those in need He places in my path care. (Acts 2:44-45)
5. By boldly **sharing** His life-saving message with the lost in order that they may be saved for eternity. (Acts 2:42, 47)

**Going deeper on your own:** Read Jeremiah 17:7-8 and Acts 2:42-47. In today's lesson, Pastor Jay said, "If people are going to withstand anything, it must begin by placing our complete trust in the one who stands over everything." Would you agree or disagree? This year at Center Point Church we are embarking on a year of growing deeper in our devotion to our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.
