What is the role of physical intimacy (Sex) in "His" - Story?

A good gift but not essential for a great life.

"In Creation" human sexuality and physical intimacy was good. (Genesis 2:18-25)

"In The Fall" human sexuality and physical intimacy was <u>distorted</u>. (Genesis 3, 4, 6, 9)

"In The Redemption" physical intimacy in marriage was restored and singleness is elevated and honored. (Gospels, epistles)

"In The New Creation" human sexuality and physical intimacy will be surpassed. (Matthew 22:29-30; Revelation 19-22)

God's theology about human sexuality, and physical intimacy

It was made for the right <u>players</u>, in the right <u>place</u>, and for the right <u>reasons</u>.

The right players and right place:

In a marriage between a man and a woman. (Genesis 2:24, Mark10:7-9)

The right reasons:

To celebrate a union and to affirm oneness. (Gen. 2:24)

For the procreation of God's family; to have kids. (Gen.1:28)

To add joy to a married couple. (Proverbs 5:15–20)

To display God's loyal, exclusive love. (Eph. 5:29–32)

God's theology on Sex and the Single life - Single is better?

"Model Jesus" - follow our single Savior. (Gospels)

To live today as we will live in eternity. (Matt. 22:29-30)

To give freedom to mission, to give <u>undistracted</u> devotion. (1 Corinthians 7)

To display God's open, <u>inclusive</u> love to everyone. (John 3:16)

The thief's (Satan) purpose is to steal and kill and destroy. My (Jesus Christ) purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life. John 10:10 (NLT)

Then Jesus said, "Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you. Yet our Lord has told us (1 John 1:9) if we were to return to him confess our mistakes that He would restore us to a healthy and hopeful future with Him. If that is you, why don't you do that right now?
