Redeeming How We Talk Reconnecting in a Disconnected World

Life and death are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it (recognize it, understand it, use it well) will eat its fruit. Prov. 18:21 (BSB)

HOW TO SPEAK LIFE IN A NOISY DISCONNECTED WORLD

1. I must choose to become incarnational again. (Being physically, mentally, and spiritually present)

*Long ago God spoke many times and in many ways to our ancestors **through the prophets**. And now in these final days, He has spoken to us **through his Son**... Hebrews 1:1-2 (NLT)*

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ... The Word became flesh (Jesus Christ) ...

John 1:1 & 14 (NIV)

"Martha, Martha," the Lord answered, "you are worried and upset about many things, but few things are needed --or indeed only one. Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken away from her." Luke 10:41-42 (NIV)

**2. I must choose to intentionally speak words of life and hope.
(God's HOPE)**

Greet one another with a holy kiss. 2 Corinthians 13:12 (NIV)

...You must all be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to get angry. James 1:19 (NLT)

A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger. Proverbs 15:1 (NIV)

Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear. Ephesians 4:29 (ESV)

Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone. Colossians 4:6 (NIV)

Going deeper on your own: Review this week's message notes. Read all of Luke chapter 10 slowly out loud. Now read Luke 10:38-42 again. Why do you think God had Luke place this event in the Bible? What do you think God is emphasizing as truly important in life? In this week's message, Pastor Jay gave us a 5-day challenge: After arriving home, intentionally disconnect from all social media and actually spend time talking with your family. Pastor Jay also gave us a biblical guideline on how to have conversations. Write out that guideline and choose to practice it in each conversation you have.
