How To Crush The Anxiety That Is Crushing My Home

(Philippians 4:4-9)

"I have told you all this so that you may have peace in me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world." **John 16:33 (NLT)**

HOW TO CRUSH THE ANXIETY THAT IS CRUSHING MY HOME...

1. I must make up my mind about who will LEAD my LIFE and my HOME.

Always be full of joy in the Lord. I say it again—rejoice! ...The Lord is near... **Philippians 4:4&5 (NIV)**

You (God) will keep in perfect peace all who trust in You, all whose thoughts are fixed on You! **Isaiah 26:3 (NLT)**

*Then Jesus said, "Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you. **Let me teach you, because I am humble and gentle at heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy to bear, and the burden I give you is light.**"* **Matthew 11:28-30 (NLT)**

*Choose this day whom you will serve,... **But as for me and my house we will serve the Lord...*** **Joshua 24:15 (ESV)**

2. I must SEEK OUT His direction in all things.

Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need... **Philippians 4:6 (NLT)**

*If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and he will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking. But when you ask him, be sure that your faith is in God alone. Do not waver, for a person with divided loyalty is as unsettled as a wave of the sea that is blown and tossed by the wind. Such people should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. Their loyalty is divided between God and the world, and they are unstable in everything they do. **James 1:5-8 (NLT)***

3. I must then DO what He tells me to do.

Keep putting into practice all you learned and received...

Philippians 4:9 (NLT)

*Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight. **Proverbs 3:5-6 (NIV)***

*Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus. **Philippians 4:7 (NLT)***

4. I must choose to LEAD my home with INTENTION instead of IMPULSE.

*Let everyone (especially my family) see that you are considerate in all you do... **Philippians 4:5 (NLT)***

*An impulsive vow is a trap; later you'll wish you could get out of it. **Proverbs 20:25 (MSG)***

Going deeper on your own. Review today's message notes and make a list of things that are causing you anxiety. Read Jeremiah 29:11-13, Ephesians 3:20, and Isaiah 55:8-9. Recognizing God's promises, if you knew He could change your situation would you be willing to let Him? Now read Philippians 4:6-9. Break it down and write it in your own words. Looking at your list, pray and ask God for what you need and then trust Him when He answers you. To trust Him you will need to do what He prompts you to do. This may require you to take something out of your life. If so, are you willing? Pastor Jay said in his message that many of us are good at writing To-Do Lists, yet have we ever (with God's help) written a Not-To-Do List? Have we ever done that for our children?
